Thanks to everyone who indicated after our first Introduction Newsletter that they are still interested in our cause (by not "Unsubscribing" to our correspondence), this huge positive response was overwhelming! Your interest in what we do is much appreciated.



Our spayday on 28 October 2008 was a huge success. We had 16 dogs and 13 cats sterilised and a number of pets also received additional vet care. A total of 28 of the 29 pets sterilised on the day were from poor communities in Rusthof, Strand and were thus transported from and to their homes by the PetPals team. The other pet that was sterilised was a rescued kitty who was rehomed some time ago. We also rescued and removed a very thin and mal-nourished dog (see photo of Daniel in the ad below) and a kitten (see photo above) from Liberty Street in Rusthof on the day. The dog is still looking for a forever home, while the kitty has already been rehomed to a wonderful forever home.

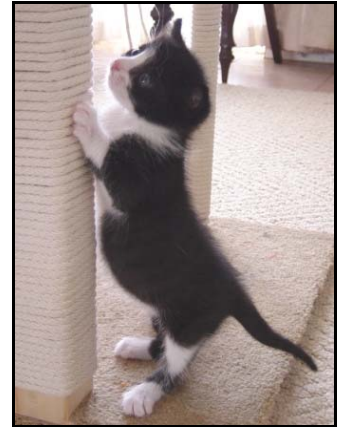
